Training on “Strengthening the Health System Response to Intimate-Partner Violence and Non-Partner Sexual Violence”

We are pleased to invite you to take part in the training on “Strengthening *the Health System Response to Violence against Women and Girls in Romania*”, organized by National Agency for Equal Opportunities between Women and Men (ANES) and East European Institute for Reproduction Health (EEIRH), with the support of the World Health Organization (WHO).

The training in Constanta will be organized on **3 – 4 July 2024, at Hotel Continental Forum** (Strada Mircea cel Bătrân, nr. 39B-41, Constanța).

The 2-day training focuses on building capacity for health managers and health service providers on strengthening the health system response to violence against women and girls:

Day 1: Introduction of the cornerstone concepts around violence against women and girls, including Intimate-Partner Violence (IPV), and the minimum standards required in health facilities to address the immediate emotional, psychological and physical health needs.

Day 2: Focuses on the essential elements on the Clinical Management of Rape and Intimate-Partner Violence (CMR-IPV) care.


The content and material of the training has been developed based on “[Caring for women subjected to violence: A WHO training curriculum for health care providers](#)”, “[Strengthening health systems to respond to women subjected to intimate partner violence or sexual violence](#)” among other evidence-based WHO’s guidelines. The accredited training will be delivered by certified trainers on CMR-IPV in Romania and credited by the Romanian College of Physicians.

The training is designed for health managers of health facilities and health departments and health care providers (physicians, nurses, midwives) from ER, obstetrics and gynecology. It would be beneficial if a health manager can attend with 2 or 3 health service providers from their same health facility.
